
Spring 2022 Guidance for New International Students with Program Start Date of January 2022 and Initial Status or Transfer Pending I-20 Issue Reason



FULL-TIME ENROLLMENT TABLE

Full-time enrollment or approved ISS Reduced Course Load (RCL) is required for your F-1 immigration status.

- Undergraduate students: minimum 12 credits; minimum 9 credits "in-
- Graduate students: minimum 8 credits; minimum 5 credits "in-person"
- Graduate TA/PA 33%: minimum 6 credits; minimum 3 credits "in-person"
- Graduate TA/PA 50%: minimum 4 credits; minimum 1 credit "in-person"
- Graduate RA 33%–50%: minimum 8 credits; minimum 5 credits "in-person"
- Dissertator: minimum 3 credits; minimum 3 credits "in-person"
- ESL: 6 credits; minimum 6 credits "in-person"
